# BURSARY INFORMATION

Chambers Plan is providing financial assistance for Alberta Chamber staff to attend [Summit 2026 in St. Albert on June 11-13, 2026.](#)

In addition to sponsoring the event, Chambers Plan is providing 15 \$500 bursaries.

**Applications are due by May 8, 2026. Successful recipients will be notified by May 15, 2026.**

## **Bursary Eligibility:**

1. Applicants must be employed with a Chamber of Commerce or Board of Trade in Alberta.
2. Applicants must be members of CCEA and CCEC. Membership is available free of charge.
3. Chambers that have not received a bursary to attend Summit in the past will receive stronger consideration.

Bursaries are awarded at the discretion of Chambers Plan, and they reserve the right to not award any bursaries from the submissions received.

## **Eligible Expenses:**

The bursaries may be awarded each year, up to a maximum amount of \$500 to cover conference registration fees, hotel accommodations and travel expenses. Eligible travel expenses may include flights, parking, meals and fuel. We will not pay mileage, but will accept fuel receipts as an eligible travel expense.

## **Bursary Application Process:**

Applications are due by May 8, 2026. Successful recipients will be notified by May 15, 2026.

Receipts must be submitted by June 30, 2026.
