BURSARY INFORMATION

Chambers Plan is providing financial assistance for Saskatchewan Chamber staff to attend Summit 2026 in Prince Albert on August 24 - 26, 2026.

In addition to sponsoring the event, Chambers Plan is providing 15 \$500 bursaries.

Applications are due by June 26, 2026. Successful recipients will be notified by July 10, 2026.

Bursary Eligibility:

1. Applicants must be employed with a Chamber of Commerce or Board of Trade in Saskatchewan
2. Applicants must be members of CCES and CCEC. Membership is available free of charge.
3. Chambers that have not received a bursary to attend PD Summit in the past will receive stronger consideration.

Bursaries are awarded at the discretion of Chambers Plan, and they reserve the right to not award any bursaries from the submissions received.

Eligible Expenses:

The bursaries may be awarded up to a maximum amount of \$500 to cover conference registration fees, hotel accommodations and travel expenses. Eligible travel expenses may include flights, parking, meals and fuel. We will not pay mileage, but will accept fuel receipts as an eligible travel expense.

Bursary Application Process:

Applications are due by June 26, 2026 Successful recipients will be notified by July 10, 2026.

Receipts must be submitted by September 18, 2026.
